The observations of the SSS are as follows.

- 1) Teacher performance in timely completion of syllabus was good.
- 2) Fairness of the internal evaluations process by the teachers was always fair.
- 3) Student Mentoring System was positive aspect of the institute which tracks overall growth of the students.
- 4) Usually teachers inform about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes to the students.
- 5) Overall the response to survey was positive.
- 6) Preparation of the teacher for class was satisfied.
- 7) Teachers usually discuss the performance of students in internal examination with students.
- 8) Institution regularly takes active interest in promoting extracurricular activities and organizing field visits.

There were few areas of concern where scope for improvement was seen. Those areas are as follows.

- 1) Encouragement of research culture among students is needed.
- 2) Need of more Skill based certificate programs and courses.
- 3) More New post-graduation courses should be started.

4) Enlarging Physical Infrastructure.

5) Number of books should increase in the library.

6) Efforts need to be made by the teachers to inculcate soft skills and employability skills.
